

Academic All-OAC Men's At-Large Team

Ohio Northern's Meilton is Lone Returning Academic All-OAC First Team Selection

Twinsburg, OH -- Ohio Northern senior tennis player **Brian Meilton (Pickerington)** is the lone returning player to have been voted to Academic All-Ohio Athletic Conference (OAC) Men's At-Large First Team two consecutive years. **Meilton** carries a 3.41 grade-point average (gpa) in international business and economics. Seven student-athletes were unanimous picks to the 2003 First Team.

To qualify for the Academic All-OAC Men's At-Large Team, a student-athlete must have a minimum cumulative gpa of 3.0, must have been a starter or key reserve who has made a significant athletic impact in matches/meets/tournaments etc. and be in at least his second year of participation in his sport. The Academic All-OAC Men's At-Large Team consists of student-athletes from the sports of golf, swimming and diving, tennis and wrestling. The Academic All-OAC Team is voted on by the OAC's faculty athletics representatives.
