

Academic All-OAC Women's At-Large Team

Three Student-Athletes are Unanimous Selections to 2003 Academic All-OAC Women's At-Large First Team

Twinsburg, OH -- Wilmington senior tennis player **Jessie Heslar (Georgetown)** and senior golfer **Jennifer Mercer (Sabina/East Clinton)** and Otterbein's **Erin Moriarty (Pickerington)** were unanimous selections to the 2003 Academic All-Ohio Athletic Conference (OAC) Women's At-Large First Team.

Heslar carries a 3.73 grade-point average in sport management and communications, Mercer has a 4.00 gpa in early childhood education and Moriarty holds a 3.99 gpa in mathematics.

To qualify for the Academic All-OAC Women's At-Large Team, a student-athlete must have a minimum cumulative gpa of 3.0, must have been a starter or key reserve who has made a significant athletic impact in matches/meets/tournaments etc. and be in at least her second year of participation in his sport. The Academic All-OAC women's at-large team consists of student-athletes from the sports of golf, swimming and diving and tennis. The Academic All-OAC Team is voted on by the OAC's faculty athletics representatives.
