OAC Announces 2004 Academic All-OAC At-Large Winners

Twinsburg, Ohio -- The Ohio Athletic Conference (OAC) has announced the 2004 Academic All-OAC Men's and Women's At-Large winners, today.

A total of 20 men and 34 women from the Conference have been named Academic All-OAC and Academic All-OAC Honorable Mention.

The men's at-large winners consist of student-athletes from the sports of golf, swimming and diving, tennis and wrestling, while the women's honorees are from the sports of golf, swimming and tennis.
