OAC WEEKLY GOLF NOTES

Baldwin-Wallace

MEN: Freshman Nick Bryan (Zanesville/ Bishop Rosecrans) carded rounds of a season-low 73 and 76 for a two-day and 36-hole stroke total of 149 to tie for ninth place individually...Senior Ryan Lewis (Canal Fulton/ Northwest) returns as an All-OAC golfer after placing 10th at the OAC Tournament a year ago...Lewis tops B-W in stroke average this spring at 77.50 strokes per 18 holes, freshman Mike Falk (Strongsville) is second at 79.44 and Bryan is third at 80.0...During the past three years, B-W has placed second, second and third at the OAC Tournament under the direction of fourth-year Head Coach Chris Kibler.

WOMEN: At the Capital-Otterbein Tournament, junior two-time All-OAC player Molly Scheetz (Canton/ Perry) placed in a tie for ninth place as she carded a team-low score of 86...Also breaking the 100-stroke mark were sophomore Lydia Cole (East Canton) with a 95 and juniors Karli Townsend (Malvern) and Shelly McKinney (Malvern) with scores of 97 and 98, respectively...At the Wilmington tourney, Scheetz fired rounds of 79 and a season-low 77 for a 156-stroke total to place second individually...Senior two-time All-OAC and Academic All-OAC player and team captain Sarah Hacker (New Albany, Indiana/ Our Lady of Providence) had rounds of 87 and a season-low-tying 85 for a 172 total to tie for 16th....Scheetz tops the team in stroke average for the season at 82.67 and Hacker is second at 89.20.

John Carroll-

MEN: John Carroll finished second among the eight teams competing at the Majestic Springs Golf Club in Chesterland, Ohio, and second among the six conference schools in the field ... The Blue Streaks posted a school record on Sunday with the lowest round score of 337 in the programs history ... Senior Laura Pareso (Washington, PA/Bishop Canevin), junior Amanda Shannon (Oak Brook, IL/Hinsdale Central) and freshman Kelly Lucas (Worthington, OH/Thomas Worthington) all finished in the top 10 in individual standings. Pareso shot rounds of 85 and 78 to place in fourth ... Pareso also set a school record for the lowest nine hole score with a front nine 32 ... Shannon was only a place behind coming in fifth with a score of 164 ... Lucas finished in sixth for the Blue Streaks shooting an 81 and 84 for a total score of 165 ... Omilion and Coder placed in the top 40, Omilion finished in 37th place shooting a 198 and Coder ended in a tie for 38th and a score of 204 ... A second place finish marks the fifth consecutive top five finish in the spring, and was the fourth top two showing of the season dating back to the fall schedule.

WOMEN: John Carroll finished fifth among the nine teams competing at the Table Rock Golf Club in Centerburg, Ohio, and fourth among the seven conference schools in the field ... Junior Amanda Shannon was the only Blue Streaks to finish in the top 20, as she shot rounds of 45 and 42 to place in a tie for 13th place ... Kelly Lucas and Brittney Coder placed within the top 30 ... Lucas shot a 47 and 44 for a total of 91 and a tie for 25th in individual standings ... Coder, who tied with Shannon for JCU's low score on day one with a 45, posted a 93 to tie for 28th ... Pareso fired a 99 to finish in 42nd and round out the scoring for the Blue Streaks.

Muskingum-

The Muskingum College men's golf team finished their final tune-up prior to the Ohio Athletic Conference Championships by capturing third at the Ohio Northern University Invitational on Sunday at Colonial Golfers Club in Lima, Ohio...The Muskies shot a team total 646 (319-327) and were led by senior Dan Fisher (New Lexington) who finished fifth in the 59-golfer field after shooting a 157 (79-78). Fisher ended the tournament second in par five scoring (+1), third in par four scoring (+6) and was tied for sixth with 20 pars. Senior Matt Shaffer (Groveport) finished sixth with a 158 (78-80). Shaffer logged the fourth most birdies (3), was fifth in par three scoring (+2) and tied for sixth with 20 pars. Junior Tony O'Linn (Beverly/Fort Frye) carded a 164 (78-86) to finish tied for 16th, while sophomore Aaron Neff (Cambridge) shot a 169 (86-83) to finish tied for 30th. Freshman Josh Colyer (Zanesville/Tri-Valley) rounded out the Muskie scoring with a 170 (84-86) to finish tied for 36th. Colyer ranked eighth in par four scoring. As a team, the Black & Magenta recorded the third most birdies (10), ranked second in par four scoring, fourth in par five scoring, fifth in par three scoring and registered the fourth most pars (83)...Following the tournament, the Muskies now stand at 41-17 in the region and 45-20 overall.

Ohio Northern

MEN: The Ohio Northern men's golf team finished third of 19 teams at the OSU-Lima Invitational and won the ONU Invitational on Saturday and Sunday. The Polar Bears set the 18- and 36-hole tournament scoring marks with a 309-325—634 victory. Northern's 36-hole total of 634 was a full 15 strokes better than the previous record of 649 set in 1995 by Capital. Junior Wes Immler (Lorain/Amherst Steele) carded rounds of 74 and 80 for a 154 and a tie for 2nd at the ONU Invitational. Immler continues to lead the team with an 81.2 average over 16.5 rounds. Junior Chase Cummings (Tulsa, Okla/Liberty-Benton) carded a career-low 73 at the OSU-Lima Invitational to finish tied for second. He is third on the team with an 83.2 stroke average in 17.5 rounds. Sophomore Ben Kretz (Roundhead/Osar American) also picked up a top-ten finish at the ONU Invitational with rounds of 78-82—160. He finished ninth and now is second on the team with an 82.4 stroke average. ONU will be back in action Thursday and Friday at the OAC Championship hosted by Capital at the Cumberland Trails Golf Club.

WOMEN: The Ohio Northern women's golf team finished third out of 10 teams with a 357 at the Otterbein/Capital Invitational Wed. at Table Rock Golf Club. Junior Meagan Brennan (Mason/Mt. Notre Dame) fired an 87 to finish tied for 13th at Otterbein, and fired an 81-77=158 to finish third at Wilmington. This season, Brennan leads ONU with an 83.3 stroke average. Freshman Megan Russell (Lambertville, Mich./Bedford) tied for ninth with an 86 at Otterbein and was 10th with an 82-86=168 at Wilmington. She is second on the squad in scoring at 87.7 this season. Freshman Kaylea Thresher (Powell/Olentangy Liberty) was 20th at Otterbein with an 89 and was 26th at
