Swimming Notes

Baldwin-Wallace junior **DJ Mosiniak (Toldedo/ St. Francis DeSales)** is ranked 16th on the list for the NCAA Division III National Swimming Championship Meet in the 50-yard freestyle...He owns the B-W school-record in the 50 free at 20.94 seconds...Mosiniak also will compete in the 100-yard freestyle at the national meet.

John Carroll freshman **Patrick Hulseman (Chicago, IL)** will be the Blue Streaks lone representative at the 2006 NCAA Swimming and Diving Championships. He was one of 22 athletes invited to compete in the 1-and-3 meter diving. He is the first JCU diver to qualify for the national championship meet since Frank D'Angelo in 1997. He is also part of the first father-son national qualifying duo in JCU swimming and diving history. Paul Hulseman, a 1982 JCU graduate, was the first JCU swimming All-American in school history.

Men's Golf Notes

Baldwin-Wallace: The men's golf team finished second of four teams at the 18-hole Whispering Woods Spring Invitational at the Whispering Woods Golf Club in Pinehurst, South Carolina....Sophomore **Matt Lewis (Canal Fulton/ Northwest)** competed as an individual and tied for medalist honors with a two-over-par 72 on the 18-hole, 6,400-yard layout...Senior **Joe Tornabene (Canton/ Jackson)** carded a 78 to tie for third, sophomore **Mike Jenior (Rootstown)** fired a 79 to tie for fifth, freshman **Bill Donatone (Geneva)** shot an 80 to tie for seventh and senior two-time All-OAC player **Bobby Santerre (Cincinnati/ LaSalle)** recorded an 81 to tie for 10th.

Track & Field Notes

Baldwin-Wallace: The track teams competed at the Annual Disney Relay Meet in Orlando, FL...With a majority of the key performers not making the trip, the women placed third of 10 schools and the men finished sixth of nine...For the women, junior **Megan Via (Brookville)** won the 1500-meter run in 5:01.03 and freshman **Ashley Scullion (Grand Rapids, MI/ Kentwood)** won the 5000-meter run in 18:51.22...For the men, junior **Chris Aurand (Hudson)** was a double winner as he captured meet titles in the discus (128-4) and hammer (133-7).

Marietta: Freshman **Jessi Larrison (Batavia)** set a new school record in the 800m run, finishing sixth with a time of 2:25.56.

Women's Golf Notes

Ohio Northern: The Polar Bears opened their spring schedule with a 355-380 loss at Northwood (Fla.) on March. 3 at the Okeeheelee Golf Course in West Palm Beach (FL) ... Sophomores **Meagen Brennan (Mason/Mount Notre Dame)** and **Amy Gillen (Troy)** led the lady Polar Bears by firing rounds of 92 and 93, respectively ... Junior **Ashley Raderstorf (Royal Center, Ind./Pioneer)** shot a 95 to finish third on the team and seventh overall ... Freshman **Maggie Batizy (Akron/Revere)** carded a career-low 100 to finish 10th and sophomore **Cory Stewart (Saginaw, MI/Heritage)** shot a career-low 101 to finish 11th.
