## OAC Announces 2006 Academic All-OAC Men's At-Large Winners

**Twinsburg, Ohio** -- The Ohio Athletic Conference (OAC) has announced the 2006 Academic All-OAC Men's At-Large winners, today. A total of 25 men from the Conference have been named Academic All-OAC and Academic All-OAC Honorable Mention. The men's at-large winners consist of student-athletes from the sports of golf, swimming and diving, tennis and wrestling.

Five student-athletes were unanimous selections - Baldwin-Wallace juniors **Alex de la Pena (Elyria/Elyria Catholic)** and **Ryan McCartney (Lorain/Admiral King)**, Ohio Northern's **Justin Hiskey (St. Mary's/Memorial)**, a senior, and **Nick Frankle (Canfield)**, a junior, and Otterbein junior **Andy Miller (Xenia)**.
