

OAC Swimming & Diving Notes

Baldwin-Wallace: at Mount Union, Men: W 143-89 Women: W 137-92

MEN: Freshman **Sean Sonneberg (Napoleon)** highlighted a men's and women's sweep at Mt. Union. Sonneberg won the 500 and 1,000-yard freestyle events and swam on the winning 400 free relay team. Sonneberg won the 500 free (4:56.24) and set a school-record in the 1,000 free (10:14.88). In addition, junior **D.J. Mosiniak (Toledo/ St. Francis deSales)** won the 50 free (22.23) and 100 free (50.68) and joined Sonneberg on the winning free relay squad...Junior Academic All-OAC swimmer **Alex de la Pena (Elyria/ Catholic)** won the 200-yard IM (2:03.97) and 200 breaststroke (2:19.10), junior **Luke Grilli (Londonderry, N.H./ Londonderry)** won the 200 free (1:50.78) and 200 backstroke (2:11.20). Freshman **Matt Laughlin (Centerville)** also won the 200-yard butterfly (2:07.95)

WOMEN: Sophomore **Ambica Iyengar (INDIA)** led the women as she won two events and swam on the winning 400 free relay team. Iyengar won the 200 IM (2:21.58) and 100 free (58.61) and was joined on the 400 free relay team by freshman **Kate Ritchey (White Oak, PA/ McKeesport)**, sophomore **Erica Brubach (Powell/ Olentangy)** and sophomore **Stephanie Markley (Mansfield)**...Ritchey also won the 1,000 free (11:49.15) and Markley won the 500 free (5:43.45)...Sophomore **Katie Krzywicki (Brook Park/ Midpark)** won both the one and three-meter diving events...Junior **Sarah Anders (North Ridgeville)**, seniors **Stephanie Zurca (Aurora/ Twinsburg)** and **Emily Wood (Carrollton)** and junior **Sara Gombash (Perrysburg/ Toledo Notre Dame)** swam on the winning 400-yard medley relay team...Anders also won the 200 back (2:24.37), Wood the 200 free (2:06.18) and Gombash the 200-yard butterfly (2:19.66).

John Carroll: at Westminster Relays, Men: 4th of 6 teams Women: 5th of 6 teams ...
at Ohio Northern, Men: L 150-84 Women: L 146-77

A miscommunication regarding location of Friday's meet (New Wilmington, Pennsylvania as opposed to Wilmington, Ohio) started the bus headed the wrong way for several miles as JCU intended to compete at the Westminster Relay Carival. By the time the correction was made, the Blue Streaks were able to arrive just as the national anthem had finished playing.

MEN:Despite the late start and no warm-up, the John Carroll men's 300-yard butterfly relay of **Ben White (West Newton, PA/Yough)**, **Kevin Draper (Pittsburgh, PA/Shadyside Academy)** and **Matt Finney (Upper Arlington)** would stroll off the bus and produce a win in the opening race of the meet (1:52.79) ... In a 150-84 loss to Ohio Northern, only freshman diver **Patrick Hulseman (Chicago, IL/Loyola Academy)** was able to win for the Blue Streaks. He had a winning final score of 209.20 in one-meter diving, and 168.90 in 3-meter diving.

WOMEN: Despite the late start and no warm-up,, the Blue Streaks started strong by winning the women's 300 yard butterfly relay. The trio of **Colleen Finn (Akron/Walsh Jesuit)**, **Rebecca Gilewicz (Marion/Harding)** and **Ashley Marsteller (Erie, PA/McDowell)** – who literally ran off the bus and headed right to the starting blocks — won the race in 2:08.45. JCU would later win a second relay (the women's 200 yard freestyle) thanks to the efforts of Gilewicz, **Christa Corabi (Wintersville/Steubenville Central)**, **Andrea Kovacs (Toledo/Notre Dame Academy)** and **Danielle McGrath (North Royalton/Padua Franciscan)** covering the distance in 1:49.63 ... On Saturday 29, John Carroll faced an inspired Polar Bears of Ohio Northern squad in what turned out to be a first time victory for the home team at the ONU Sports Center. Although the Blue Streaks lost, 146-77, they did see a few event victories. **Heather Gilmour (Warren/Howland)** was the stand out Blue Streak as she won both the women's 1000-yard freestyle (11:38:21) and the women's 500-yard freestyle (5:36:21).

MEN: At Wooster, **Donald Maclary (Virginia Beach, VA/Landstown)** took honors in the 200 IM with a time of 2:07.75 ... Against B-W, freshman diver **Brandon Hood (Chagrin Falls/Kenston)** was a double-winner taking the one meter dive (121.20) and the two meter dive (119.50).

WOMEN: At Wooster, **Kristin Bellay (Alliance/Marlington)** won the 1,000 free (12:16.94) ... Against B-W, **Erin Schwing (Greensburg, PA/Greensburg-Salem)** won the 50 free (26.75), while **Kelly Lammers (Westlake)** finished first in the 200 breast (2:45.19).

MEN: ONU is 2-0 overall and 2-0 in OAC action after victories over Wilmington Friday night and John Carroll on Saturday ... Junior **Nick Frankle (Canfield)** won three events against Wilmington (200 I.M., 100 breast and 200 medley relay) and three events against JCU (1000 free in 10:34.85, 100 breast in 1:00.75 and 200 medley relay) ... Freshman **Brett Kuhn (Tiffin/Columbian)** won three events against Wilmington (50 free, 100 free, 200 free relay) and three events against JCU (50 free in 22.47, 100 free in 48.99 and 200 free relay in a school record 1:29.60) ... Freshman **Nethaniel Peyton (Tinley Park, IL/Lincoln-Way East)** won three events against Wilmington (200 IM, 200 medley relay and 200 free relay) ... Freshman **Robert Frankle (Canfield)** won three events against JCU (200 free in 1:50.50, 500 free in 5:04.22 and the 200 free relay in a school record 1:29.60) ... Sophomore **John Miller (Lebanon)**, Robert Frankle, Kuhn and Peyton combined to win the 200 free relay in a school record time of 1:29.60 ... Senior **Lukas Letinaker (Lancaster)** won three times against JCU (200 IM in 2:05.67, 100 fly in 55.47, 100 back in 58.47).

WOMEN: ONU is 2-0 overall and 2-0 in OAC action after victories over Wilmington Friday night and John Carroll on Saturday ... Juniors **Kristin Dickey (Kettering/Dayton Christian)** and **Jessica Ewald (Tiffin/Calvert)** led ONU by winning three events in each meet. Dickey won the 200 IM, 100 fly and 200 medley relay against WC and the 200 free (2:05.56), 100 fly (1:02.64) and the 200 medley relay (1:54.28) against JCU, while Ewald won the 200 free, 100 breast and 200 medley relay against WC and the 200 IM (2:21.56), 100 breast (1:09.42) and the 200 medley relay in (1:54.28) against JCU ... Senior **Emily Gruenhagen (Wauseon)** won three times against Wilmington, finishing first in the 800 free, 400 free and 200 free relay ... Senior **Julia Wilson (Pendleton, IN)** won the 100 free (58.55), the 200 medley relay (1:54.28) and the 200 free relay (1:47.82) against John Carroll ... Sophomore **Mary Williams (Grandview Heights)** also won three events against JCU, winning the 100 back in 1:04.42, 200 free relay in 1:47.82 and the 200 medley relay in 1:54.28.
