Baldwin-Wallace: vs. Morningside: Men-W 121-72, Women-W 127-82

MEN: Versus Morningside, seven individuals won as well as one relay team. Winning individually were freshman **Sean Sonnenberg (Napoleon)** in the 200-yard freestyle, Mathias in the 50 and 100-yard breaststroke events, junior **D.J. Mosiniak (Toledo/ St. Francis de Sales)** in the 50 and 100-yard free events, junior **Luke Grilli (Londonderry, NH)** in the 100 back, and junior **Alex de la Pena (Elyria/Catholic)** in the 100-yard individual medley. Swimming on the winning 200-yard free relay team were Grilli, Mosiniak, Sonnenberg and sophomore **Dave Fournier (Perrysburg/ Toledo St. John's)**.

WOMEN: Against Morningside, nine women won individually and two relay teams also were victorious. Individual winners were senior **Emily Wood (Carrollton)** in the 200-yard freestyle, junior **Sarah Anders (North Ridgeville)** in the 50-yard backstroke, senior **Stephanie Zurca (Aurora/ Twinsburg)** in the 50-yard breaststroke, junior **Sara Gombash (Perrysburg/ Toledo Notre Dame)** in the 100-yard butterfly, freshman **Kate Ritchie (White Oak, PA/ McKeesport)** in the 100-yard free, freshman **Mallory Hoffman (Gahanna/ Mount Carmel College)** in the 100 back, sophomore **Stephanie Markley (Mansfield)** in the 100-yard breaststroke and sophomore **Ambica Iyengar (India)** in the 100-yard individual medley. Swimming on the winning 200-yard medley relay team were Anders, Zurca, Gombash and Markley. Swimming on the winning 200-yard free relay team were Wood, Ritchie, freshman **Kelsie Baker (Dover)** and Iyengar.

MEN: Against Hiram, junior **Nick Frankle (Canfield)** and freshman **Brett Kuhn (Tiffin/Columbian)** led the Polar Bears by winning three events each. Frankle won the 200 individual medley in 2:02.20, the 200 breaststroke in 2:13.48 and was a member of the winning 400 medley relay. Frankle is also ranked 16th nationally in the 100 breast, an event that was not contested on Saturday. Kuhn made his mark by winning the 200 freestyle in 1:47.87, the 100 freestyle in 48.65 and he was also a member of the winning 400 medley relay team. Senior **Lukas Leitnaker (Lancaster)** won the 200 butterfly in 2:10.74 and was a member of the winning 400 medley relay team. Freshman **Nathaniel Peyton (Tinley Park, IL/Lincoln-Way East)** took first in the 50 freestyle in 22.50 and the 200 backstroke in 2:07.32. Freshman **Robert Frankle (Canfield)** and sophomore **Mike Anderson (Jenison, MI)** won the 1650 freestyle in 17:29.31 and the 500 freestyle in 5:15.57, respectively. The team of sophomore **John Miller (Lebanon)** Nick Frankle, Kuhn and Leitnaker won the 400 medley relay in 3:43.58.

WOMEN: Junior **Jessica Ewald Tiffin/Columbian)** broke the ONU record in the 200 breaststroke in 2:26.55 which also surpasses the NCAA "B Cut." She is also ranked eighth nationally in the 100 breast, an event that was not contested on Saturday. Ewald also placed second in the 200 freestyle in 2:05.99. Junior **Kristen Dickey (Kettering/Dayton Christian)** took second in the 200 individual medley in 2:25.58 as well as the 200 butterfly in 2:25.55. Senior **Emily Gruenhagen (Wauseon)** took first in the 500 freestyle in 5:34.80. Freshman **Marian Kousaie (Kent/Roosevelt)** won the 3-meter diving with a score of 122.60.
