OAC Announces 2006 Academic All-OAC Women's At-Large Winners

Twinsburg, Ohio -- The Ohio Athletic Conference (OAC) has announced the 2006 Academic All-OAC Women's At-Large winners, today. A total of 35 female student-athletes from the Conference have been named Academic All-OAC and Academic All-OAC Honorable Mention. The women's at-large winners consist of student-athletes from the sports of golf, swimming and diving and tennis.
