OAC Announces 2005 Academic All-OAC Women's At-Large Winners

Twinsburg, Ohio -- The Ohio Athletic Conference (OAC) has announced the 2005 Academic All-OAC Women's At-Large winners, today. A total of 26 female student-athletes from the Conference have been named Academic All-OAC and Academic All-OAC Honorable Mention. The women's at-large winners consist of student-athletes from the sports of golf, swimming and diving and tennis.

Ohio Northern seniors, **Lindsey Jakubchak (Strongsville)** and **Karen Lee (Mt. Vernon)**, and Otterbein fourth-year tennis player **Chelsea Thresher (Powell/Olentangy)** were unanimously named Academic All-OAC.
