
OAC Women's Tennis Notes

BALDWIN-WALLACE: vs. John Carroll, L 6-3 ... at Capital, W 8-1

Junior No.1 singles and doubles standout **Andrea Isaac (New Philadelphia)** was the only B-W player to have a 2-0 mark in both singles and doubles last week.

CAPITAL: vs. Mount Union, L 9-0 ... vs. Baldwin-Wallace, L 8-1

Freshman **Sara Seneski (North Royalton)** picked up the Crusaders lone win this past week as she won in #5 singles against Baldwin-Wallace on Saturday afternoon; Seneski improves to 2-4 overall in singles play.

HEIDELBERG: at Ohio Northern, L 9-0 ... vs. Tiffin, L 8-1 ... vs. Wilmington, L 5-4

Freshman **Amanda Hanning (Galion)** went 3-1 on the week at third singles with a 6-3 and 6-4 win against Tiffin and an 7-5, 4-6, 6-4 win against Wilmington ... At third doubles the duo of junior **Kara Dittmar (Springboro)** and freshman **Dawn Neumeyer (Parma)** earned a win at third doubles against Wilmington ... Junior tandem of **Meghan Michaels (Fremont/Ross)** and **Janetta Christmas (Green Springs/Clyde)** won at first doubles against Wilmington.

JOHN CARROLL: vs. Baldwin-Wallace, W 6-3 ... at Muskingum, W 8-1

JCU needs three more victories to tie and four to break the program record for consecutive wins. The record of 14 was set between Apr. 13, 1991 and lasted through the 1992 season ... Against Baldwin-Wallace in a 6-3 win Tuesday, it was a big day for the quartet of **Shannon Benic (Pittsburgh, PA/Oakland Catholic)**, **Lauren Castagnero (Pittsburgh, PA/Ellis School)**, **Kate Leckenby (Mt. Lebanon, PA/Mt. Lebanon)** and **Bea Lopez (Sandusky/Centerville)**, as all four players went 2-0. Benic and Lopez won a pivotal #2 doubles match by a 9-7 score over Tiffany Allison and Krista Marshall, while Castagnero and Leckenby dominated with an 8-1 win at #3 doubles ... Benic, who is just a freshman, was involved in yet another pivotal victory in singles play. Her 2-6, 6-2, 10-8 triumph over 2005 second team All-OAC sophomore Meggie Glassburn at #3 singles sealed the victory in the Blue Streaks' favor. Castagnero, Leckenby and Lopez all won in straight sets at #4, #5 and #6 singles, respectively ... Against Muskingum John Carroll played without Benic, yet still managed to post an 8-1 victory. The victory was the team's 11th consecutive victory to open the 2005-06 season ... Despite the four players affected by the bump up in the line-up — **Sara Crane (Hudson/Walsh Jesuit)**, Castagnero, Leckenby and Lopez — won their #2 thru #5 singles matches by a combined score of 48 games to seven.

MARIETTA: vs. Muskingum, W 7-2 ... at Ohio Northern, L 9-0

Marietta (1-4, 1-2 OAC) picked up an impressive 7-2 victory over rival Muskingum Tuesday. Freshman **Amanda Carraher (Hilliard/Davidson)**, playing in her first collegiate match, teamed up with senior **Lauren Stermer (Ocala, FL/Forest)** to win first doubles, 8-0. Junior **Katie Chadwell (Georgetown)** and **Justine Pagenhardt (Oakland, MD/Southern Garrett)** also earned a point in third doubles; they won 8-5. Carraher was victorious in first singles 6-2, 6-1; Stermer took her second singles match 6-0, 6-2. Sophomore **Elizabeth Smith (Vienna, WV/Parkersburg Cathoic)** won at third singles 6-1, 6-1. Chadwell claimed a win in fourth singles, winning 6-4, 6-0. Pagenhardt picked up her second victory of the year at sixth singles, 6-3, 6-2.

MOUNT UNION: vs. Capital, W 9-0 ... vs. Otterbein, W 7-2

Individually, junior **Eleni Halkias (Warren/W.G. Harding)**, senior **Lisa Pikus (Perry)**, junior **Erin Meglich (Willoughby Hills/Willoughby South)**, freshman **Leslie Douglass (Geneva)** and junior **Sara Payne (East Liverpool)** each went 2-0 in singles play last week. Douglass won for the fourth consecutive time at #4 singles, while Payne won her third straight at #5 singles. Both are 9-1 in their last 10 matches. Halkias and sophomore **Nicole Camardo (Canfield)** improved to 7-4 overall at #1 doubles.

MUSKINGUM: at Marietta, L 7-2 ... vs. Ursuline, W 8-1 ... vs. John Carroll, L 8-1

Freshman **Brittany Ward (Lancaster/Bloom Carroll)** improved to 2-0 and 1-0 in League play with wins over Ursuline and John Carroll at sixth singles... Freshman **Courtney King (Cambridge)** notched wins at fourth singles and fifth singles against Ursuline and Marietta, respectively.

OHIO NORTHERN: vs. Heidelberg, W 9-0 ... at Wooster, W 9-0 ... vs. Marietta, W 9-0 ... vs. Tiffin, W 7-2

The Ohio Northern women's tennis team posted a 4-0 mark last week, improving their record to 14-2 overall and 2-0 in Ohio Athletic Conference action ... Senior **Ashley Jones (West Chester/Lakota West)** went 4-0 in singles to become ONU's all-time career singles wins leader and lead the Polar Bears to a 4-0 record last week. Jones also went 4-0 in doubles action. Jones was 4-0 at Nos. 3-4-5 singles and is 14-5 on the season. She also combined with three different partners to go 4-0 in doubles play. This season, she is 10-8 in doubles play and is 24-13 overall. In her career, she is 72-22 in singles, 57-34 in doubles and is 129-56 overall. She is 10 wins shy of the record 139 overall wins by Karen Lee from 2002-05 and is 14 doubles wins shy of Lee's career mark of 71 ... Sophomore **Kaitlyn Macdonald (Warsaw, IN)** went 4-0 in singles and 4-0 in doubles action last week. She was 2-0 at No. 1 singles, 2-0 at No. 2 singles and was 4-0 at No. 1 doubles during the week. This season, she is 13-5 in singles, is 12-6 in doubles and is 25-11 overall ... Freshman **Natalie Larew (Dublin/Coffman)** also went 4-0 in singles play and 4-0 in doubles action last week. Larew is 13-3 in singles, 11-5 in doubles and is 24-8 overall ... Sophomore **Courtney Anderson (Amherst/Steele)** ran her win streak to nine matches with three singles wins during the week. She also combined with Larew to go 4-0 in doubles play. This season, Anderson is 14-5 in singles, 16-3 in doubles and is 30-8 overall. In her two-year career at ONU, Anderson is 39-7 in singles, 25-3 in doubles and is 64-10 overall ... This season, ONU is 82-32 in singles and 39-18 in doubles for an overall record of 121-50.

OTTERBEIN: vs. Wilmington, W 8-1 ... at Mount Union, L 7-2

Otterbein swept singles play to open the week with an 8-1 win over Wilmington. The Cardinals then battled but fell short for a 7-2 loss to Mount Union with wins from sophomore **Rachel Kerr (Wheeling, WV/Wheeling Park)** at no. 6 singles and the team of junior **Ashley Tackett (Marion/Harding)** and sophomore **Shannon Carr (Westerville/North)** at no. 3 doubles.

WILMINGTON: at Otterbein, L 8-1...vs. Miami-Middletown, W 8-1 ... at Ohio Dominican, L 9-0 at Heidelberg, W 5-4

Freshman **Carolyn Shinsato (Batavia)** posted a win at No. 6 singles to lift Wilmington past Heidelberg for the Lady Quakers' first OAC win of the season. For the week, sophomore **Andrea Gibson (Blanchester)** picked up a pair of wins at No. 1 singles to raise her record to 4-4. Sophomore **Liz Amling (London)** and **Sarah Amling** are now 4-4 on the doubles court following wins over Heidelberg and MUM. Liz Amling and freshman **Debra Stewart (Circleville/Logan Elm)** both collected singles wins against MUM and Heidelberg.
